## PACK AWAY HUNGER

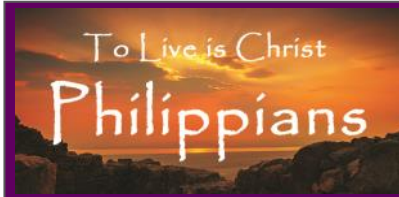

**READ Philippians, chapter 1.**

2. Paul complimented the church at Philippi. What positive things can you say about our church?
3. To what degree do you share Paul's passion for the gospel? How can you better equip yourself to speak confidently in the Lord?
4. What about your lifestyle do you most want to change in your desire to live for Christ? How can you better encourage your brothers and sisters in Christ?
