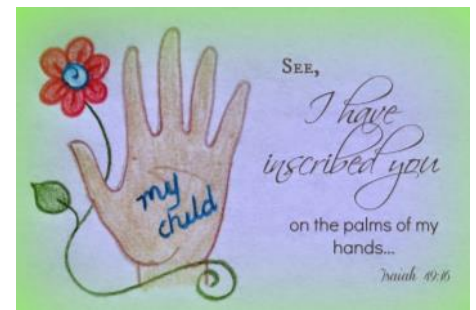
"I Have Engraved You On The Palms Of My Hands."

(Text: Isaiah 49:8-16a)

Context: Isaiah the prophet was called by God to be a mouthpiece of God to the erring and wandering children of Israel. Through Isaiah God warned His people not to follow the path of the erring northern tribe of Israel who had allowed the worship of false gods among their people. They had made foolish alliances with foreign powers and had been overthrown by foreign

governments. Isaiah warned the people of Israel in Judah not to do the same things. Yet, King Ahaz, after being warned by Isaiah not to form an alliance with the Assyrians did so. Mannaseh, a godless king of Judah, allowed worship of false gods. Through Isaiah, God provided the people of Israel a faithful voice calling the people back to trust in the LORD. With this great lack of faith in the LORD being displayed by even its leaders, faithful believers were tempted to think that God had indeed turned His back on them and that He would not care for them any more. Isaiah offered them a message filled with hope as he described God's compassionate and faithful love. Through Isaiah, God says,

"I will not forget you...I have inscribed you on the palms of my hands."

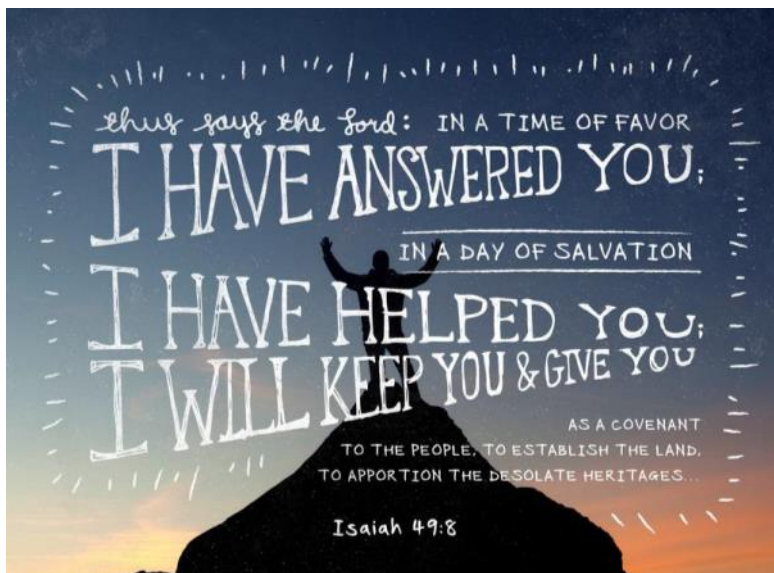


I. With The Sinful and Faithless Behavior Of Our Unbelieving Neighbors We Can Feel Like A Forgotten Minority.

- A. People declare that God has forgotten them when bad things happen (if there is a god, they contend).
 - 1. When selfish, hurtful, and evil behavior becomes so dominant in society that people call it normal, people can become cynical saying that God must have turned away His face. They feel that God doesn't even care about people. Some say that this is evidence that a good God must not exist. (Such was the case in Isaiah's day.)
 - 2. The strong dominate over the weak and make up their own rules.
- B. Even inside the Body of Christ, voices can be heard from time to time saying, "Where is God? If He truly loved us, He would do such and such."
 - 1. True believers in Isaiah's time were severely tested in their trust of God. (King Ahaz made an alliance with pagan Assyria and King Mannaseh even encouraged the worship of pagan gods.)
 - 2. These believers must have felt fatigued and almost hopeless.

II. God's Faithful Love Is Not Overpowered By Sinful Behavior.

- A. He knows us and thinks of how best to care for us every day.
 - 1. A human proverb applauds the faithful love of a mother toward her child, but even a mother's love can possibly end in the middle of great turmoil.
 - 2. Speaking to Zion, God says, "Can a woman forget her nursing child and have no compassion on the son of her womb? Even these may forget, but I will not forget you. Behold, I have inscribed you on the palms of my hands. Your walls are continually before Me" (Is. 49:15-16). (*The intimate things about you are always on My mind. *You will be rebuilt, restored, and once again have your proper glory.*)



- B. He promises that our "destroyers and devastators" (those who would harm our bodies and souls) will depart from us (Is. 49:17).

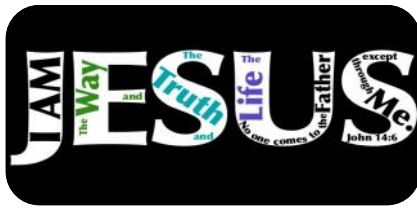
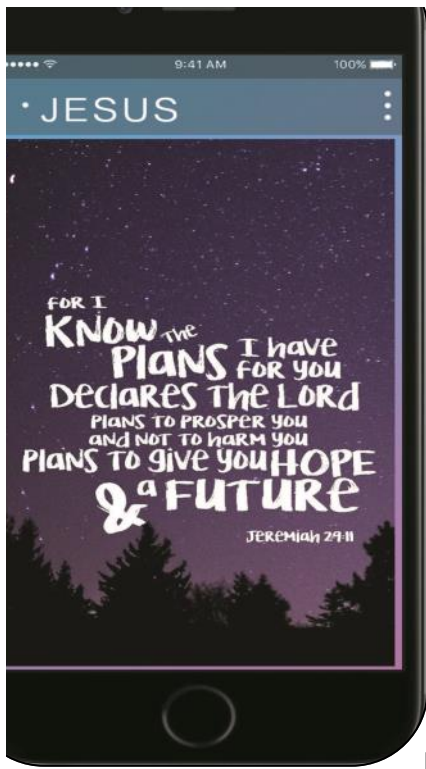
1. God has promised, then, kept His promise, to win the contest over the Evil One. (Genesis 3:15; Romans 16:20).

a. Full forgiveness of sins is a reality for those in Christ. Restored.

b. Peace, temporal and eternal, with a holy God has been secured.
